## **THE HONOURABLE WALTER S. TARNOPOLSKY AWARD**

### **2017 NOMINATION INFORMATION**

#### **CRITERIA:**

This prize, which is not necessarily presented annually, is awarded to a person whose contribution and dedication to the field of human rights merits recognition.

#### **ELIGIBILITY:**

- Candidates must be Canadian residents.
- Candidates must be nominated as individuals.
- For 2017, candidates may be at any stage of their career

#### **NOMINATION PROCEDURE:**

- Nominations must be submitted by individuals.
- Nominations must be accompanied by a completed nomination form, a concise Curriculum Vitae, and such other supporting materials as will allow the Selection Committee to make an informed decision.

#### **AWARD SELECTION COMMITTEE:**

The recipient of the Award is made by a committee comprised of a representative of the International Commission of Jurists, the Canadian Bar Association, the Canadian Superior Courts Judges' Association, and the Canadian Association of Law Teachers.

#### **PRESENTATION:**

The Award, which consists of a bronze medallion and holder and a \$1,000 honorarium, is presented publicly. The location of this year's presentation has yet to be determined. In recent years it has been presented in the winner's hometown.

#### **DEADLINE:**

The deadline for receipt of all nomination materials is April 30, 2017.
